Promoting preventive healthcare {item 1 (i) in GSR 130 (E)}	Development of diagnostic centre for preventive healthcare.

- a) Contribute to the corpus : Please provide the funding that can be used as corpus fund. Income from the corpus can be used for supporting resource centres and organizational activities.
- b) Project Based Funds: Companies can provide funds for projects, creation of Centres, Startups with clearly defined milestones.
